

Instructions for Authors

General

The oncology Section encourages the submission of manuscripts that address issues of relevance to oncologic physical therapy in all spheres. All correspondence is sent to the first author named on the manuscript unless otherwise requested. Research publications receive the highest priority for publication, but case reports, technical reports, literature reviews, and perspective papers are all solicited on an equal basis. *Rehabilitation Oncology* will accept a manuscript for publication with the understanding that the manuscript, with any original findings or data, has not been published previously or is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts that have been presented elsewhere orally at a scientific or professional meeting should contain a footnote stating that fact, for the benefit of the reader.

Manuscripts published in *Rehabilitation Oncology* are the property of the Oncology Section, and may not be published elsewhere without the permission of the Section. The Section reserves the right to reproduce, publish, and distribute the manuscript. For research reports, a statement that the rights of animals and human subjects have been protected must be included with the manuscript. Authors must obtain written permission to use photographs in which the subjects are recognizable. Authors must also obtain and submit written permission from original sources to publish illustrations, figures, or tables taken from those sources.

Rehabilitation Oncology ascribes to the essentials of writing and reviewing research papers, with the accompanying standardized manuscript checklists, sponsored by the Physical Therapy journal. These guidelines and the necessary checklists can be found on the oncology section web site www.oncologypt.org. There are separate checklists for clinical trials, observational studies, systemic reviews/meta analyses, and case reports. **THE APPROPRIATE CHECKLIST SHOULD BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH YOUR MANSUCRIPT.**

Manuscript Preparation

For format and reference style, please consult the American Medical Association (AMA) *Manual of Style*, most recent edition, published by Lippincott, Williams and Wilkins of Baltimore, Maryland. All manuscripts must be typed double spaced, including references, with pages numbered; font size preferred is 12 point type. Every manuscript should contain a title page and short abstract. On the title page, include the title, author(s), and footnote containing the basic autobiographical data of the authors. The abstract should be 150 words or less. Referencing is by Arabic superscripts that appear sequentially in the text. Tables should be numbered consecutively and placed after the reference list. Figures should also be numbered consecutively and placed after the references and tables. Appendices, if any, should also be numbered consecutively and positioned at the end of the paper.

ALL SUBMISSIONS ARE TO BE SENT ELECTRONICALLY ONLY. The paper should be in WORD and sent as an attachment. A cover letter should accompany the manuscript, giving the corresponding author's address, day and evening phone numbers, fax number, and e mail address.
